INFORMATION FOR PARENT/GUARDIAN

Dear Parent / Guardian,

Imagine you are a young child and you awake one night to find your bedroom filling with smoke. Your house is on fire! What would you do?

To make sure your child has the skills that can potentially save his/her life, we will be teaching them how to avoid fires & what to do in case of a fire. A key element of this learning process will include a tour at your school with the Fort Lee Fire Department's Fire Safety House.

This 35 foot mobile classroom is specially designed to teach children vital fire safety techniques through a fun, safe simulation of common hazards. Our fire safety house has a kitchen, bedroom & living room and features smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors.

In addition, the fire safety house fills with non-toxic smoke to teach children to crawl low to safety. A heated bedroom door helps children to choose the right exit, which is a ladder from one of the windows.

If your child suffers from asthma, other respiratory conditions or allergies that may be irritated by the non-toxic smoke OR if your child has special considerations, please indicate that on the permission form before allowing him/her to tour our fire safety house. **PLEASE RETURN THE COMPLETED FORM TO YOUR CHILD'S TEACHER PRIOR TO OUR VISIT!**
