

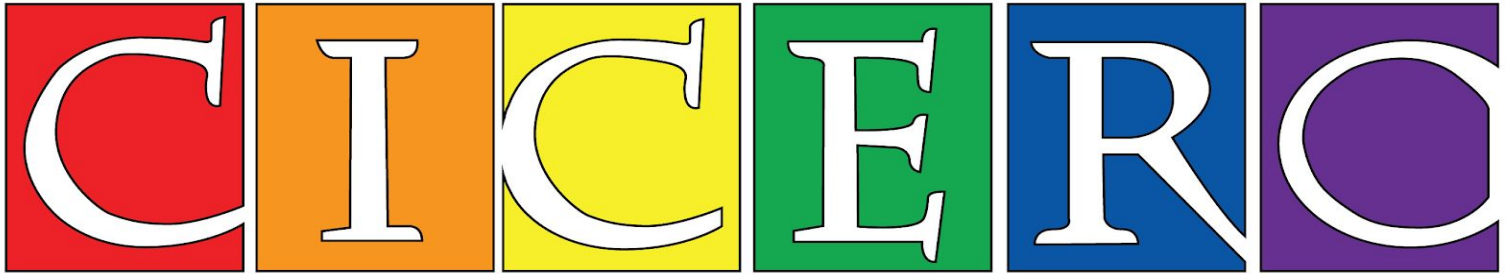

### **What Kind of Books?**

**Yes:** New and very gently used hardcover and paperback books for children aged pre-school through 8<sup>th</sup> grade, including picture books, early readers, fiction, nonfiction, and biographies

**No:** Textbooks, adult books, library discards, or reference books

***We will only accept High School books that are considered "classics"***
