We are proud that the S4 Environmental Club was awarded a grant of nearly \$1,000 last spring for their work in the field!

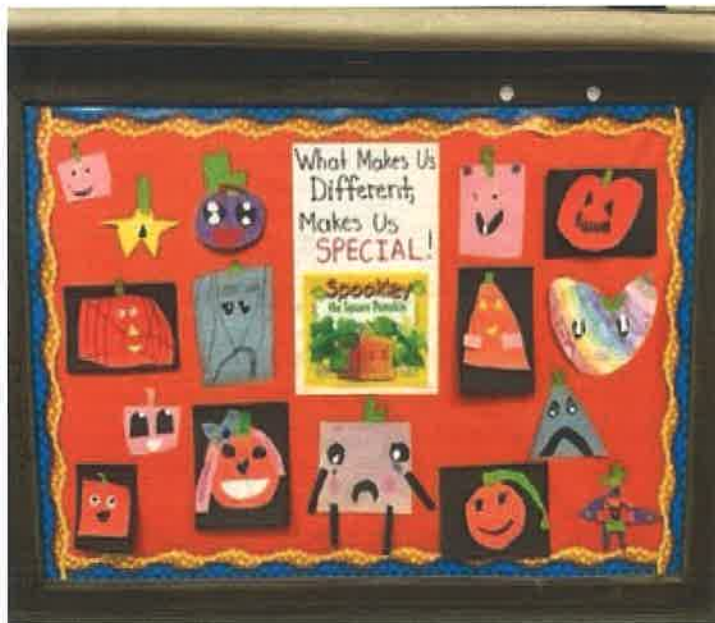
